We will focus on improving the Precinct by supporting the sustainability and long-term planning of our Village.

Promote existing businesses and encourage others to shop local, in order to allow our Precinct to thrive in an age when local high streets are under constant pressure. We will do this via council initiatives - such as 'LiveLoveLocal', social media, and the InTouch newsletter.

Welcome investment from new businesses. Encourage fresh life to our shopping centre, as well as new local jobs - motivating us all to spend our money on local businesses, instead of made-in-China online shops.

Ensure long-term planning allows for long-term prosperity. We will work together with the Fareham and Hampshire councils for the benefit of our Precinct. A long-term focus would be re-surfacing the Precinct pavement.

Back and support local community groups.

Too many people in Portchester have suffered from isolation and loneliness during the COVID lockdowns, we need to ensure that we all have a strong group of people looking out for one another in Portchester all-year-round.

Fight anti-social behaviour. We will get in contact to organise for Hampshire's Police Commissioner to visit Portchester to take her around the village and discuss solutions to frequent issues, such as speeding.

Get young people involved in the community, giving young people the chance to develop their leadership skills and make a difference to the community.
