FAREHAM'S ECONOMY

Hundreds of new jobs created at Solent Airport at Daedalus; we will enable thousands more with Solent Airport being self-supporting as flight numbers grow.

We will upgrade all playgrounds, having built new ones at Holly Hill, Daedalus Common and Abbey Meadows. We'll continue to support youth services via Y-Services. We will continue to improve safety and security in Fareham Town Centre with a zero tolerance of begging and anti-social behaviour and new CCTV cameras and patrols.



We will continue to campaign for minor injuries treatment, elderly care and maternity beds at Fareham Community Hospital as well as finding a public transport solution.

FAREHAM'S HOUSING

We are working hard to ensure that a South Hampshire Green Belt is created including the Meon and Stubbington/South Fareham countryside strategic gaps which would prevent further housing development. We will maximise the development levels on brownfield

We will deliver Welborne's 6,000 homes and infrastructure to serve Fareham's housing needs removing the need to find even more land to build them



but lobby to reduce any need to have housing that is not necessary to meet Fareham's needs.

FAREHAM'S TRANSPORT

We have worked with the highway authority to bring forward over £100m of roads investment:

Stubbington Bypass, Newgate Lane North and East, St Margaret's Roundabout, Peel Common Roundabout and A27 dual carriageway from Segensworth to Fareham.

We will continue to work through the planning process to get further improvements to our road system paid for by developers.

Now that our pledge that not a brick will be laid at Welborne until infrastructure funding, including full funding for J10 on to the M27, is in place has been fulfilled we will work with developers to ensure the timely provision of that infrastructure

We also plan to extend the Eclipse bus rapid transit service around the Borough including to Welborne.



FAREHAM'S FINANCES

We froze the council tax for seven years and have recently been increasing it by just a penny a day for the FBC element giving us the 5th lowest council tax in the country. That is our pledge for the future.

We invest in commercial property in Fareham which brings benefits in terms of keeping council tax low and preserving excellent services. We only raise 16% of overall spending from council tax and are very careful with your money, which is why we continue to set almost the lowest district council tax in the country while providing some of the best services, costing less than £3 per week for the average home.



FAREHAM'S ENVIRONMENT

We have delivered our pledge to ban the use of singleuse plastics by the Council and we are committed to the Council achieving net zero carbon by 2030 and will have delivered a carbon reduction plan. Actions not words.

We will work with the police to see zero tolerance of pavement parking, which is both antisocial and dangerous, as well as parking of untaxed vehicles and more action on antisocial behaviour and vandalism. We are running an anti-littering campaign across the Borough as we spend over £1m keeping the Borough clean and tidy – "No more rubbish excuses!" We aim to introduce a recycling scheme for pots, tubs and trays as well as food waste and we will continue a massive programme of tree planting on Council land.
