# 'I will fight this hospital NHS red tape scandal'

IT COST £25m to build, but Fareham's state-ofthe-art Community Hospital has only worked a 45-hour week Mondays to Fridays since it opened 5 years ago.

**Tina Ellis** says it cannot operate to full capacity or expand to incorporate other vital services because it's bogged down in NHS red tape.

She says: "Although funded by a type of Private Finance Initiative, it will never be able to operate fully in the interests of residents if this excessive bureaucracy continues as up to five different organisations are needed to agree on any decisions."

So her main pledge is to help Fareham MP Suella Fernandes, who has launched a task force to discuss the issues, to campaign to fight for the hospital to be put to its full and proper use.

**Tina** added: "Please elect me to help our MP and others to fight for more services – an out-of-hours surgery would be a start."
